India Fund Raising Status

Last year, we had received donations totaling \$36,627 for three facilities/institutions in India, (1) Halari Visa Oshwal Boarding and Kanya Chhatralay, Jamnagar, Gujarat, (2) Oshwal Yatrik Gruh, Palitana, Gujarat and (3) Halari Visa Oshwal Mahajanwadi in Bangalore.

We had transferred \$21,840 to Oshwal Yatrik Gruh in Palitana. Renovation of wing "C" is already complete and work for wing "B" & "A" will start from December 1, 2009. All takhtis were prepared by a painter at Jamnagar. Takhtis are inscribed on granite and then all words were applied golden varakh (golden colors). All taktis were put on walls in the waiting hall on October 13, 2009. Last year, committee members of Halari Visa Oshwal Boarding and Chhatralay agreed with our plans for computer systems. Then, they decided to use this fund for higher education scholarships. Our president Keshav Shah insisted and convinced them to give our youngsters the opportunities to learn and use computer technology. We are in process of transferring money for eight (8) computers and one year training cost. Remaining money will be transferred each year for training for next 3-4 years. We are also waiting for bank account information to transfer \$1,485 to Halari Visa Oshwal Mahajanwadi in Bangalore. It will be transferred in few weeks.

Treasurer's Report

We have currently account balance of \$14,986.17 at the end of October. However, we have donations payable to HVO Boarding and Kanya Chhatralay for \$13,301.67 and HVO Samaj (Bangalore Mahajanwadi) for \$1,485.67. We are in process of transferring these donation amounts. Thus, our available balance is only \$198.84 which will be used for minor administrative and website costs.
